



LogicMonitor Trial Checklist

To make your trial setup go quickly, please take a few minutes to prepare your systems by doing the following:

1. Select a host to install the agent on. It doesn't need to be dedicated, but it does need at least 512 M of available memory. It must be a Windows machine if you will be monitoring other Windows machines, otherwise any Windows or Linux host will do.
2. Ensure that host has Java 1.6 or later installed. You can download it from java.com if needed.
3. We recommend Chrome as the browser that gives the best performance with LogicMonitor.
4. For monitoring Windows servers, identify or create a domain account with local admin privileges that will be used to run the agent service. Ensure you have the password for that account.
5. For all other devices:
Ensure that snmp is enabled, and accessible from the agent host:
If needed, you can install snmpd on Linux hosts with `yum install net-snmp`,
`apt-get net-snmp`, or `zypper install net-snmp` depending on your Linux distribution.
6. If you will be monitoring NetApp devices, identify or create an account on the NetApps for API access. Ensure you know the password for that account.

7. For monitoring databases, ensure you have an account and credentials that can connect (read-only) to the database.
